General Information: **REVISED 5-26-09**

- ◆ The Draw is **closed**. Please check your schedules.
- ◆ Games will be played at 1) J.H. Hull at Sam Levy School, 3420 W 229th Pl, Torrance, 90505 (All 8U and 10U games are at Levy) and 2) Charles Wilson Park, 2200 Crenshaw Bl., Torrance, 90501 Wilson Park is located two blocks North of the Sepulveda Bl. and Crenshaw Bl. intersection on the East side of the street. Please check the website (www.tgsl.org) or see enclosed map for Levy and Wilson locations.
- ◆ **PARKING AT WILSON FIELDS: You must park in Lots D, E, and F (the East parking lots). Trailers and motor homes in Lot E only. Parking Lots B and C are closed to TGSL Tournament Parking. There is a Farmers Market during the Tournament and parking is only permitted in designated areas. Please see separately attached parking map.**
- ◆ No pre-game warm-up allowed on the infield dirt area.
- ◆ No 'soft-toss' hitting balls against the fences at anytime.
- ◆ 12" Dream Seam for the 12U and 14U, 11" Sof-Dot for 10U, and 10" Sof-Dot for 8U.
- ◆ The dugouts at Levy are shaded.
- ◆ No bleachers on Levy fields, please bring folding chairs or blankets for the grass.
- ◆ Parking at Levy Fields only in designated areas. Many will need to park on the street.
- ◆ Remind your families to bring shade.
- ◆ Our Snack Bar at Levy fields will be open on all days.
- ◆ We will have vendors at Levy fields on Saturday and Sunday.
- ◆ **No pets, smoking, or alcohol at Levy/Hull school property, per Torrance Code.**
- ◆ We will have snacks and drinks at Wilson Park.
- ◆ Farmer's Market at Wilson Park on Saturday for snacks, healthy food.
- ◆ Trophies for 1st and 2nd Place in each division.
- ◆ No profanity or abusive remarks. Keep comments positive
- ◆ No infield practice on fields at any time.
- ◆ Three games guaranteed for each game. Game time is forfeit time.
- ◆ "Spirit of the Game" medals will be awarded by opposing managers after each Pool Play and first-round elimination game and go to a player who made a great play, exhibited great sportsmanship, or did something unique or spectacular. Please check with rival manager to make sure a girl has not previously in the Summer Classic.

Tournament Rules: REVISED 5-26-09

Check-in time is at least one hour before your first game time.

For 8U and 10U check-in table will be located next to Levy Field 1.

For 12U and 14u, check-in table will be at Wilson Park in the center of the park.

Rosters and proof of insurance are required at check-in.

Teams also need ASA photo ID cards or birth certificates at check-in.

Ages are as of Dec. 31, 2008.

- Pool games are 6-inning maximum with DROP DEAD at 1 hour, 20 minutes.
- If Drop Dead Time is reached (1 hours, 20 minutes), score reverts back to last complete inning, unless
 - (1) Home Team takes the lead in bottom half of last inning and time runs out. Home team wins because it does not need to make three outs.
 - (2) Home team is trailing entering last inning and ties the game in bottom half of last inning and time runs out. Then games ends in a tie. Ties in Pool games stand.
- For elimination games up through semifinals, No New Inning may begin after 1 hour and 20 minutes. (No Drop Dead Time). 6-inning Maximum if time is not reached. Tie games will move to the International Tiebreaker. Ties must be resolved in elimination games.
- Championship game has no time limit. 7 innings in 10u, 12u and 14u. 6 innings in 8U.
- **Mercy rule for all games: 10 runs after 4 innings, 8 runs after 5 innings.**
- Protests are not accepted in Pool Games. For Protests in elimination games, the fee is \$75 cash, payable in advance. Cash only. Refundable only on reversal. The tournament director or his designee, or the UIC, will rule on protests using the ASA rulebook. Protest decisions will be made immediately and all decisions are final. Have your cash ready.
- Three games are guaranteed for each team. Game time is forfeit time.
- Game time starts with the first pitch.
- The team on the top of the bracket, or listed first, will occupy the 1st base dugout.
- The team on the bottom of the bracket, or listed second, will occupy the 3rd base dugout.
- In case of back-to-back games on the same field, a team may remain in the same dugout.
- Home Team will be decided by a coin toss prior to the start of your game.
- Home Team keeps score in its team book. Umpire score card is the official score.
- Umpires are responsible for turning in official score cards after each game.
- In Pool Play, wins are worth 1 point and ties ½ point. Pool Play Tiebreakers: 1. Head-to-head, 2. Fewest runs allowed, 3. Most runs scored. 4. Coin Flip.
- All teams must bat Round Robin (everybody bats, free substitution) for Pool games

- 10u, 12u and 14u have the option of round-robin batting or using DP/Flex in elimination games. If a team has Round Robin batting, team may have free substitutions. Manager must declare this option to umpire before the game. Each team makes its own selection.
- With Round Robin batting, courtesy pinch runners are allowed for pitcher and catcher only, and must be last previous out.

8-U RULE MODIFICATIONS: REVISED 5-26-09

All ASA Junior Olympic Rules apply, except as follows:

- No Infield Fly Rule
- No Dropped Third Strike
- No Hot Plate. A runner may not steal home.
- No Coach-Pitch. Walks Count.
- Only one base will be awarded on an over-throw.
- Round-robin batting and free substitution for all 8U games. All Players must bat.
- Base paths are 55 feet. Pitching distance is 30 feet.
- 10 Defensive players are allowed on the field at a time. Four outfielders must begin each play on the outfield grass.
- A play at a base during a steal or an attempted pickoff, or an over-throw to the pitcher, does not release the runners to steal.
- Runners may steal only one base per pitch.

10-U RULE MODIFICATIONS: REVISED 5-26-09

All ASA Junior Olympic Rules apply, except as follows:

- Pitching distance is 35 feet.

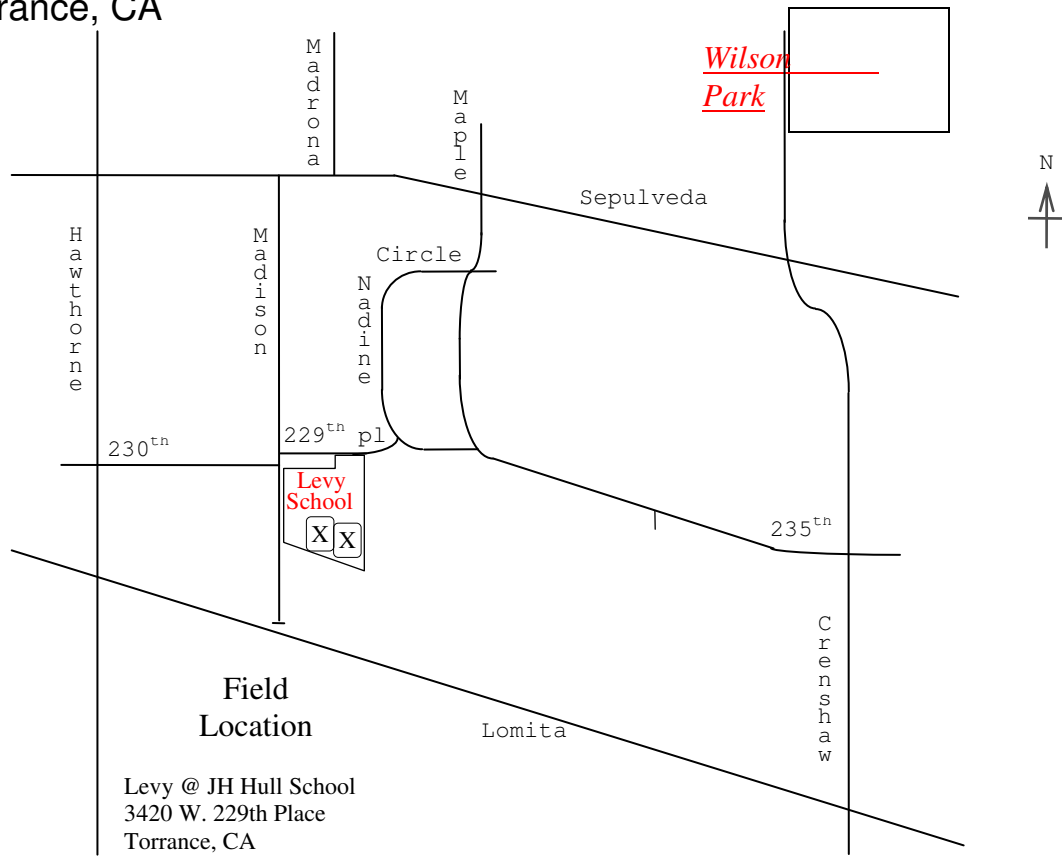

FROM 110 Fwy: Exit at Sepulveda Blvd. (From South 110 OFF-RAMP turn right onto Sepulveda // From North 110 OFF-RAMP turn left onto Sepulveda.) Proceed WEST on Sepulveda for ~ 3½ miles. You will cross Crenshaw Blvd. After crossing Crenshaw, Maple will be the second light. Turn left onto Maple Ave. Proceed SOUTH to the second light. Turn right onto Nadine Circle. Proceed WEST to the stop sign and turn left onto 229th Place. Proceed West for a half a block and turn into the Sam Levy School driveway entrance. Proceed to the back of the school.

FROM 405 Fwy: Exit at Crenshaw Blvd. (From North 405 OFF-RAMP turn left onto 182nd st then another quick left onto Crenshaw // From South 405 OFF-RAMP turn right onto Crenshaw.) Proceed SOUTH on Crenshaw for ~ 3½ miles. You will cross Sepulveda Blvd. After crossing Sepulveda, 235th St will be the next light. Turn right onto 235th St. Proceed WEST (until you curve around to Northbound) to the third light. Turn left onto Nadine Circle. Proceed WEST to the stop sign and turn left onto 229th Place. Proceed West for a half a block and turn into the Sam Levy School driveway entrance. Proceed to the back of the school.
